EUROPEAN UNION PRIZE FOR CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURE - MIES VAN DER ROHE AWARD 2009

Production studios for “Les Balles C de la B-LOD, phase 1”

It is a great pleasure to inform you that your above-mentioned work has been proposed for consideration by the jury of the European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture - Mies van der Rohe Award 2009.

The primary objective of this official prize of the European Union is to recognise and commend works of contemporary architecture that are characterised by conceptual, aesthetical and technical excellence.

The works are nominated by a group of independent experts as well as the European national architects' associations. For each biennial edition, the jury chooses from among these proposals a single work to be granted the Prize and a single work for the Emerging Architect Special Mention. In addition, the jury makes a selection of works to be published in the catalogue and presented in a travelling exhibition. The Prize consists of 60.000 € and the Emerging Architect Special Mention consists of 20.000 €. In addition, the authors of the works granted the Prize and Special Mention receive a sculpture that evokes Mies' German Pavilion of Barcelona - which is a veritable symbol for the objectives behind the award.

We would be very grateful that you send us information and documentation about this work, which we would like to receive in two phases:

Phase 1) At this time, we ask that two types of information be sent:

1. Basic Information Form

Please find a form that indicates specific information that would be important for us to have about this work, yourself and your office.

2. Two Photographs of Proposed Work

Two photographs of the proposed work, free of photographic copyrights, with the following specifications:

- Resolution: 72 dpi (pixels/inch).
- Format: jpg.
- Size: 1024 points (wide for horizontals) or 768 points (high for verticals).
- Image colour mode: RGB
- Photographer's name

Please have your office send the attached form and photographs by return e-mail by **Tuesday, October 28, 2008.**

This information and the photographs are not for publication or for the jury meeting. Rather the purpose is to confirm the basic information about the work in accordance with the rules for the Prize and to complement the database of the proposed works.

Phase 2) During the first part of November we will ask for more complete documentation about your work that we would like to receive by mid-December, for the first jury meeting.
